 - If both teams have the same number of heats won, the team in the higher division will gain entry.
 - The Grand Final CT competition is for exhibition only and AFA Title Points will not be awarded.

❖ **\$96 seems like a random amount for team entry. What's going on there?**

❖ **Can we park on the field?**

As the fields are sporting fields and have only just been remediated in January 2022 in preparation for our event, we ask that competitors don't drive on the field. There is ample car parking available and is only a very short walk to the competition/ring area

❖ **Are you able to cater for particular Dietary Requirements?**

We will have vegetarian and vegan options available for those who have requested them. If you have a particular requirement, please note it on the booking form and we will contact you to see what we can do.

❖ **Will the camping have hot water for showers?**

As fun as Wim Hoff is in the middle of winter (even a Queensland winter), we're still fans of hot showers. There will definitely be hot water for showers

❖ **Will alcohol be available to purchase?**

As a Veteran's Centre, no alcohol can be purchased onsite. Flyballers are able to BYO alcohol but this must be consumed in the camping/entertainment area only. In accordance with AFA Rules, no alcohol is to be consumed in the Competition Ring.
